He is full Professor of Sociology at the Public University of Navarra (accredited in 2010) and have gained recognition for 24 years of quality research (CNAI). He has been Lecturer with Tenure at the former university from 1995; lecturer at the University of Castile-La Mancha (1992-1995); invited visiting professor in the Center for Mobilities Research (Department of Sociology, Lancaster University, UK); and invited research in the Social, Political and Territorial Sciences of the University of Aveiro (Portugal). He is Convenor of the Research and Study Group "Southern and Mediterranean Europe" (formed within the European Society for Rural

Sociology); member of the Research Stream 17 “Transformative Rural-Urban Connections” (European Sociological Association); member of the Network of Excellence “Investigaciones Socioterritoriales y Desarrollo Rural” (Spanish Program for Promoting Scientific Research of Excellence); member of the international “Network of Sociospatial Studies”. He has been member of the Research Group “Charles Babbage in Labour Social Sciences” (Complutense University of Madrid), the Spanish Network of Urban Studies and the “Sociospatial Studies Network” (CSO2009-05805-E/SOCI). His research interests focus on the role of mobilities in regional development, urbanism and planning, rural sociology and sociology of labour.

The research results have been presented by more than thirty scientific contributions to international meetings on urbanism, the congresses of the European Society for Rural Sociology, the Ibero-American Colloquiums of Rural Studies, and the World Congresses of Rural Sociology. These findings and research knowledge have been transferred more than a dozen of research contracts; the organization of international conferences and specialized meetings; and the teaching of masters and post-graduate studies for the training of sociologists, architects, geographers, municipal authorities technicians, agricultural extension agents and international cooperation agents at the Spanish Agency for Cooperation and Development, the Spanish Ministry of Agriculture, the National Association of Sociologists, the Basque Country University, the International University of Andalusia, the National Distance Education University and the Public University of Navarre. He has been Director of two doctoral programmes at the Public University of Navarre; Vice Dean of the Faculty for the Social Sciences and Humanities and Chair of the Department of Sociology.
